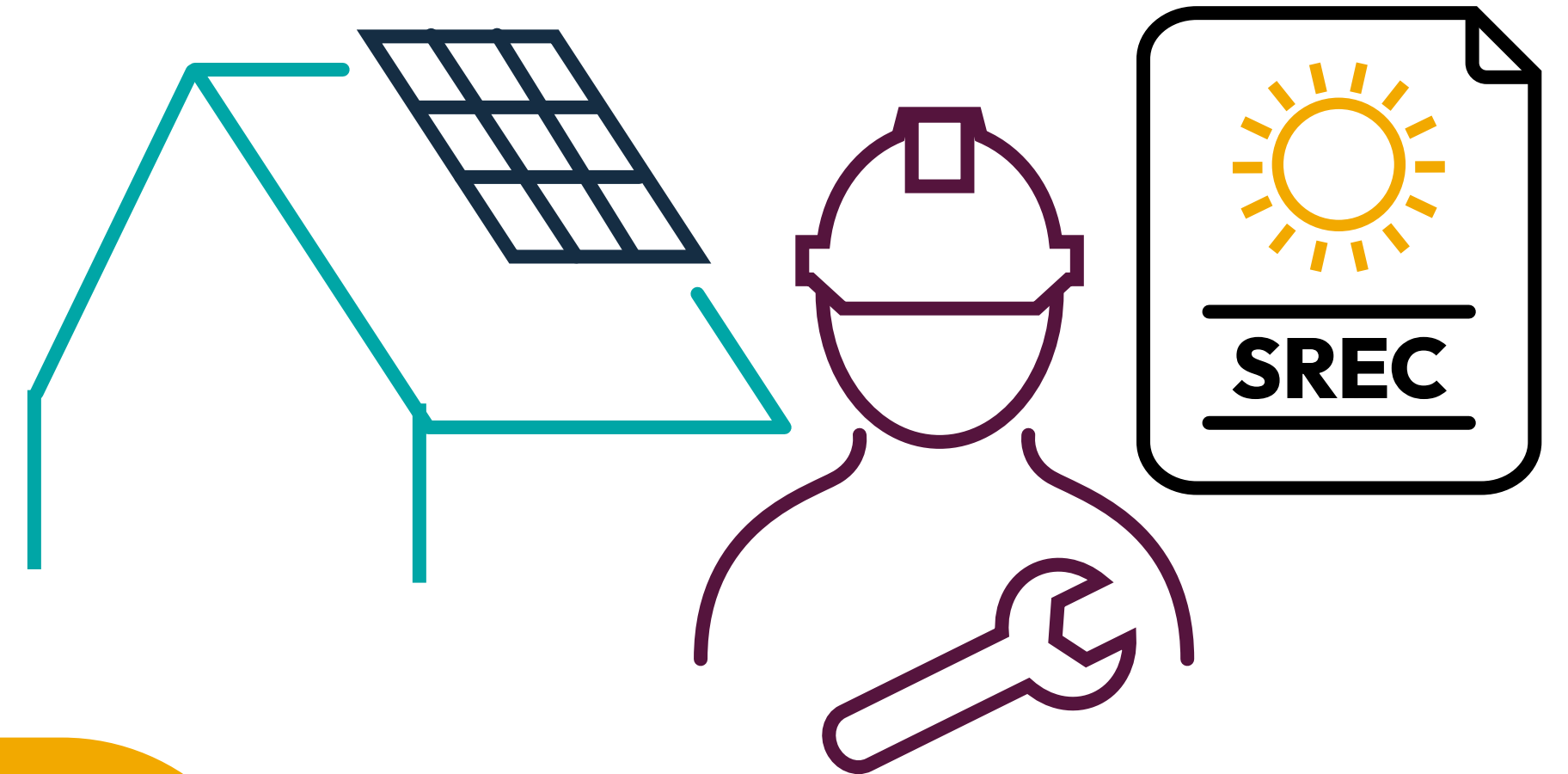
# SOLARIZE GREATER PHILADELPHIA

Homeowner participates in Solarize Greater Philadelphia, installs solar panels with an approved contractor, pays monthly for low-cost lease to vetted company that owns the home's solar electricity.

Solar company owns and maintains the equipment, generates clean renewable electricity, receives solar renewable energy credits (SREC) produced by the system.



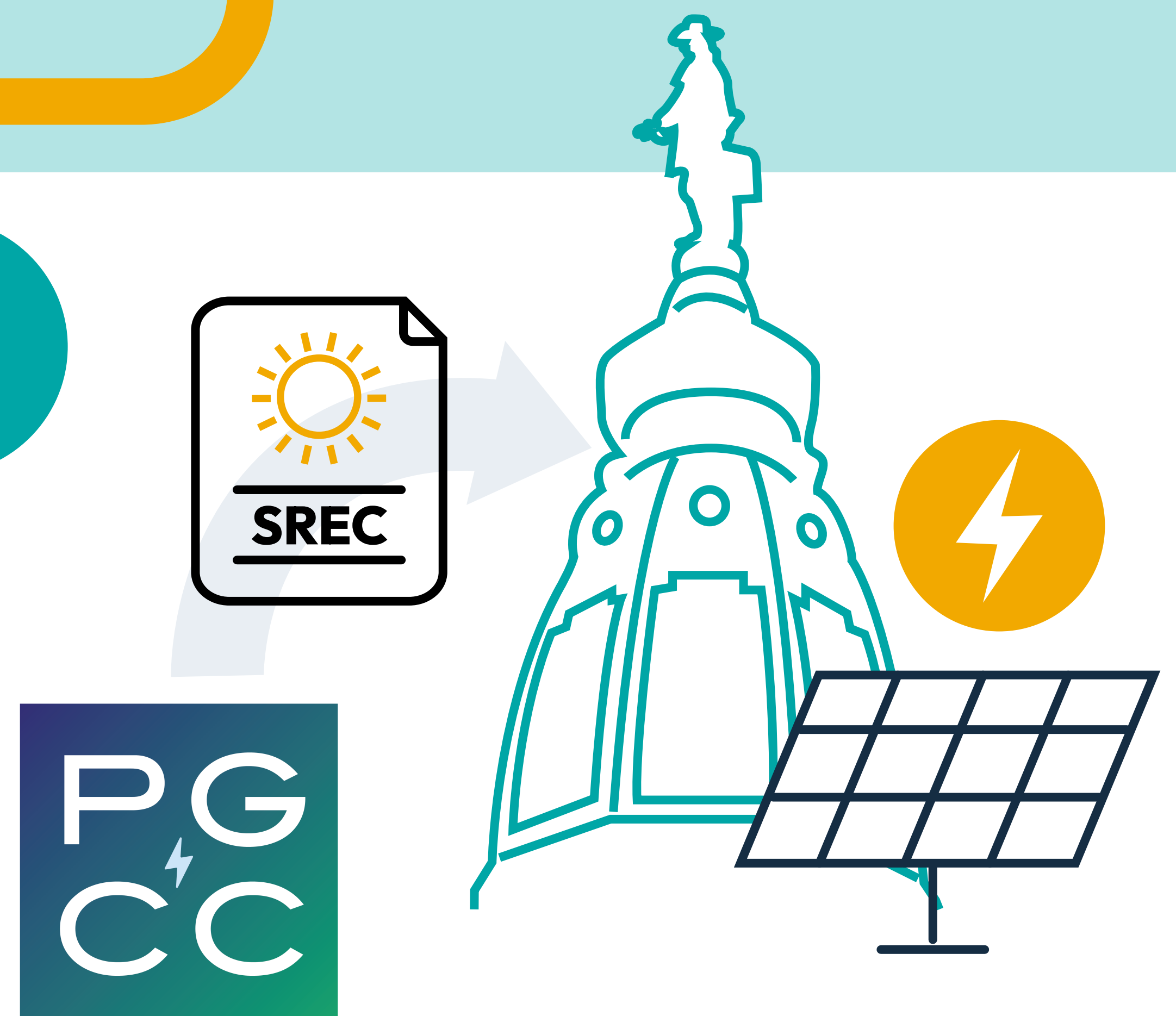

PGCC purchases SRECs at above-market price, providing market certainty for the local solar industry.

PGCC sells SRECs to City of Philadelphia, supporting municipal target to generate or buy 100% electricity from renewable sources by 2030.

PGCC deposits the sale proceeds into the SREC Revolving Fund, which supports the purchase of additional SRECs, providing capital for more Solarize projects and supporting solar adoption for homes in the Built to Last program.
